

She shows that for many writers, the national mission of language revival was entwined with a sense of mourning and loss. These writers perceived and simultaneously produced the language as neither dead nor fully alive. Henig argues that it is this figure of the living dead that lies at the heart of the revival discourse and which is constitutive of Jewish nationalism. *On Revival* contributes to current debates in comparative literary studies by addressing the limitations of the national language paradigm and thinking beyond concepts of origin, nativity, and possession in language. Informed by critical literary theory, including feminist and postcolonial critiques, the book challenges Zionism's monolingual lens and the auto-Orientalism involved in the project of revival, questioning charged ideological concepts such as native speaker and mother tongue.
