first Spanish Mexican Texas settlers He is suddenly accused of smuggling contraband horses and mules from Mexico Justa is the ranch matron She is a wise curandera folk healer whose counsel is sought by all Sabi is Justa s daughter and helps her mother with her duties at La Paz Both of them are part of Don Roberto s extended family Epifania Epi Martinez is a Gutierrez relative who works at the courthouse Amble Macray is a rich Anglo Saxon cattleman from Fort Worth He grew up with the Gutierrez family He and his family are very supportive of Tejano culture and respectful of the Spanish Mexican roots of Texas Amble has two brothers One of them Deck is now the sheriff Deck reluctantly participates in Don Roberto s persecution and prosecution They have one sister Libby They also have a half sibling Raymundo a U S marshal Scott Johnson is Don Roberto s defense attorney Scott is an idealistic young lawyer who is defending his first case George R Reed is a former county judge who controls most significant activities in the community As the area political boss he wants Rancho La Terror Town Stuart M.
