"The Lamb"

 "The Lamb," like many of Blake's poems, uses simple sentence structure and diction. What is the overall effect of this stylistic decision? What keeps the poem itself from being simple?

The effect of the simple sentence structure and diction contributes to the poem's overall innocence. The lamb is a symbol of innocence and childhood and the simplicity of the sentences alludes to the simplicity of the innocence the author is trying to portray. The poem is kept complex by the pastoral ideas suggested throughout and the calling out to God and thanking him for their creation and life. Those ideas are not simple and are very complex when religion is brought into the picture.

"The Tyger"

What emotional progression does the poem imply in the speaker's contemplation of the Tyger? How does the speaker's attitude about the Tyger change during the poem?

At first, the speaker is in awe of the creation of the tiger. Throughout the poem, he compares the purpose of creating the tiger to the purpose of creating the lamb. In this comparison, his attitude becomes confused because how could something be so innocent be created by the same being that created the fearful, somewhat evil tiger.
