through dehydration and rehydration were shown up to more than 8 days The development of the individual colour measurement values was based on the liquid flow through the tooth and its tissues in particular during drying and rehydration and gave information about dynamics and the temporal extent of these processes On the basis of this data Hoffmann had developed several methods for research and practice suggestions for feasible innovations such as monitoring of dental treatment to protect against pulp damage based on drying and reconstructing the colour of naturally moist teeth on those that have already dried the identification of the living and the dead human and animals via the dental fingerprint and a novel method of measuring the time of death for forensic medicine He also described a time limit of drying up to which relatively natural suitable colour values and shade matching results can be obtained and after which no colour determination should be carried out and he established the rehydration time after the end of the drying or dental treatment which must be waited in order to regain a natural tooth colour and to get correct values and results again His findings also show that teeth are able to store information on for example the condition liquid content colour values and the time within the drying and liquid re absorption chronology The author articulates a dental chronometer tooth clock dental data store tooth data store and a dental memory tooth memory and believes that significant progress in this field may include and could be achieved via a neural network for colour measurement apparatus A book for anyone interested in the natural sciences Pickard's Manual of Operative Dentistry Avijit Banerjee, Timothy F.
