#### Grammar 1: The Present Perfect & Pluperfect Subjunctive

When we want to express our hopes, dreams, doubts, disbelie's, or uncertainties about actions in the past, we use the Present Perfect & Plaperfect Subjunctive. This is the equivalent to saying that you believe, but are unsure, something "has" or "had" occurred.

The perfect tenses are formed by using habor + past participle.

Example: Hablar	Have spoken / had spoken
Yo	haya hablado, hubiera hablado
TO	hayas habiado, hubieras habiado
Et/ella/usted	haya hablado, hubiera hablado
Nosotros	hayamos hablado, hubiéramos hablado
Elikos/elikes/usbedes	hayan hablado, hubieran hablado

#### Compare the perfect subjunctive tenses by examining the trigger phrases.

#### I. Present Perfect Subjunctive:

Es posible que havas hablado español. (It's possible that you have spoken Spanish.)

#### 2. Pluperfect Subjunctive:

Era posible que hutieras hablado español. (It was possible that you had spoken Spanish.)

\*If the trigger physic is in the present tense, use the present perfect.

"If the trigger phrase is in the past tense (preterite or imperfect), use the pluperfect.
