Grammar 1: The Present Perfect & Pluperfect Subjunctive

When we want to express our hopes, dreams, doubts, disbelief, or uncertainties about actions in the past, we use the **Present Perfect & Pluperfect Subjunctive**. This is the equivalent to saying that you believe, but are unsure, something "has" or "had" occurred.

The perfect tenses are formed by using **haber + past participle**.

Example: Hablar	Have spoken / had spoken
Yo	haya hablado, hubiera hablado
Tú	hayas hablado, hubieras hablado
El/ella/usted	haya hablado, hubiera hablado
Nosotros	hayamos hablado, hubiéramos hablado
Ellos/ellas/ustedes	hayan hablado, hubieran hablado

Compare the perfect subjunctive tenses by examining the trigger phrases.

1. Present Perfect Subjunctive:

Es posible que **hayas** hablado español. (It's possible that you **have** spoken Spanish.)

2. Pluperfect Subjunctive:

Era posible que **hubieras** hablado español. (It **was** possible that you **had** spoken Spanish.)

*If the trigger phrase is in the **present** tense, use the **present perfect**.

*If the trigger phrase is in the **past** tense (preterite or imperfect), use the **pluperfect**.
