mere announcement of a set of key precepts for man and society In Judaism the Ten Commandments are considered an epitome of the vast body of biblical legislation a concise statement of a mere 172 Hebrew words that was presented as a credo that could easily be memorized and serve as a basic list of essentially easily understandable general rules It was not expected that the ordinary citizen would remember or fully understand the plethora of commandments found in the Torah that demand compliance and observance by the children of Israel their descendents and those who chose to cast their lot in life with them To understand the meaning and significance of the Ten Commandments in Judaic thought it is therefore necessary to correlate them with the body of legislative enactments set forth in the Torah dealing with the same subject matter a rather complex endeavor that this study hopes to facilitate *Between Faith and Reason* Dr. Martin
