This paids is organized according to the major sections of the National Institutes of Health Grant Application Instructions (SF424). This document is not exhaustive and should not be used as a replacement for a thorough review of federal guidelines and advice and guidence from experienced colleagues and Plantovitch Center staff. It is largely based on a summary guide for grant applications' provided by the National Institutes of Health.

Project Surrenery/Abstract

The purpose of the project summary/abstract is to seccinctly describe every major aspect of your proposed project. It should contain a statement of objectives and proposed methods. Consider the significance and innovation of the projected research when properly the project summary.

The second component of the project summary is a description of your proposal's relevance to public bealth. Use plain language that can be understood by a general audience, and don't include any proprietary or confidential information.

The summary must be no longer than 30 lines of acts and follow the required four and margin specifications (use Ariat, Helwetica, Palatine Linetype, or Georgia typeface, a black foot color, and a four size of 11 or 12 points; margins must be set at 0.5 inches on all sides of the document).

The abstract should include the following components:

- brief background of the project.
- specific stms, objectives, or hypotheses
- significance and relevance of the proposed research to public health.
- unlaw features and innevation of the project.
- methodelogy to be used.
- encoded regulate.
- description of how your results will affect other research areas

He succinct but include all necessary information. Avoid describing your past accomplishences, and avoid using the first person. A good strategy is to write your abstract last so it reflects the entire progress.

Communicate Place.

The research strategy/glan is organized into three sections: significance, innovation, and approach. The assessment of this research plan will largely determine whether or not your application is favorably recommended for funding. For an application with multiple specific sines, you may address the significance, innovation, and approach for each aim individually or address all the aims collectively.

Length requirements vary depending on the grant format (for example, RDI grants must not exceed 12 pages). Visit the NBI Grants website¹ for detailed information on page length notifications for varying application traces and sections.
