sufficiently sensitive to falsify some theoretical proposals all need to be addressed in open interdisciplinary dialogue This Frontiers Research Topic is aimed at stimulating discussion about current methodological issues and trends in consciousness research We welcome theoretical and empirical contributions as well as empirical articles from both experts and young scientists who work in the field of consciousness research Submissions of related hypotheses original research articles case reports perspectives reviews opinions and commentaries are welcome We very much hope that this Frontiers Research Topic will contribute to enhancing our characterization and understanding of the methodological and conceptual challenges associated with the study of human consciousness **Combining Minds** Luke Roelofs, 2019-01-28 Combining Minds is about the idea of minds built up out of other minds whether this is possible and what it would mean if it were Roelofs surveys many areas of philosophy and psychology analysing and evaluating denials and affirmations of mental combination that have been made in regard to everything from brain structure to psychological conflict to social cooperation In each case he carefully distinguishes different senses in which subjectivity might be composite and different arguments for and against them concluding that composite subjectivity in various forms may be much more common than we think Combining Minds is also the first book length defence of constitutive panpsychism against all aspects of the combination problem Constitutive panpsychism is an increasingly prominent theory holding that consciousness is naturally inherent in matter with human consciousness built up out of this basic consciousness the same way human bodies are built up out of physical matter Such a view requires that many very simple conscious minds can compose a single very complex one and a major objection made against constitutive panpsychism is that they cannot that minds simply do not combine This is the combination problem which Roelofs scrutinizes dissects and refutes It reflects not only contemporary debates but a long philosophical tradition of contrasting the apparently indivisible unity of the mind with the deep and pervasive divisibility of the material world Combining Minds draws together the threads of this problem and develops a powerful and flexible response to it

Developing Synaesthesia Nicolas Rothen, Julia Simner, Beat Meier, 2015-07-24 Synaesthesia is a condition in which a stimulus elicits an additional subjective experience For example the letter E printed in black the inducer may trigger an additional colour experience as a concurrent e g blue Synaesthesia tends to run in families and thus a genetic component is likely However given that the stimuli that typically induce synaesthesia are cultural artefacts a learning component must also be involved Moreover there is evidence that synaesthetic experiences not only activate brain areas typically involved in processing sensory input of the concurrent modality synaesthesia seems to cause a structural reorganisation of the brain Attempts to train non synaesthetes with synaesthetic associations have been successful in mimicking certain behavioural aspects and posthypnotic induction of synaesthetic experiences in non synaesthetes has even led to the according phenomenological reports These latter findings suggest that structural brain reorganization may not be a critical precondition but rather a consequence of the sustained coupling of inducers and concurrents Interestingly synaesthetes
