Cowhey and Aronson's examination of these dynamic developments lead to a measured proposal for authoritative soft rules that requires governments to create policies that achieve certain objectives but leaves the specific design to national discretion. These rules should embrace mechanisms to work with expert multi stakeholder organizations to facilitate the implementation of formal agreements, enhance their political legitimacy and technical expertise and build flexible learning into the governance regime. The result will be greater convergence of national policies and the space for the new innovation system to flourish.

Neoliberalism, Postmodernity, and the Contemporary Memorial-Building Boom Nicola Clewer, 2022-06-06. The book develops a new approach to and a distinct reading of the contemporary memorial building boom which began in the 1980s. Locating the origins of this boom in the crises associated with postmodernity and the rise of neoliberalism, it analyses the complex interplay between neoliberalism, postmodernism and nationalism in some of the most well known memorials and memorial museums to have emerged in the USA and Germany over the last four decades. Rather than offering a survey of contemporary memorials, it traces a specific trajectory and certainly not the only one ripe for analysis from the postmodern memorials of the 1980s to the increasingly monumental and authoritative memorials and memorial museums being constructed today. Developing a distinct interdisciplinary approach, the book offers a critical analysis of the relationship between the memorials, the visitor experience they are intended to offer and the understanding of history and our relation to it which underpins their philosophical, ethical and political stance. argues that contemporary national memorials reflect one of the most significant convergences between postmodern thought and neoliberal ideology both project a permanent present urging us to recreate ourselves in the light of existing conditions for there is no alternative

Seize the City, Undo the State Serhiy Kudelia, 2025 How do separatist conflicts arise and spread When does separatism become a cover for a foreign aggression How do local communities respond when state institutions collapse and militants take over The armed conflict in Eastern Ukraine which started eight years before Russia's full scale invasion contains unique evidence to address each of these questions In *Seize the City Undo the State* Serhiy Kudelia offers an authoritative study of the conflict at its initial stage 2013-14 based on a meticulous comparison of mobilization dynamics in over dozen towns of Donbas as well as in two major cities outside of it Kharkiv and Odesa Through his extensive travels and numerous interviews with conflict witnesses and participants Kudelia explains how a small group of Russian agents and local militants succeeded in eliminating state control over the largest and most densely urbanized region of Ukraine but failed to do it elsewhere Kudelia challenges the conventional accounts of the armed conflict in Donbas which portray it either as an interstate conflict entirely manufactured by Moscow or as a civil war that broke out without any external influence Instead he argues that local actors prepared ideological and organizational basis for the uprising but the successful spread of separatist control resulted from the covert intervention of Russian agents and widespread collaboration

with them of town administrators and community activists His findings also show that when enough members of local communities organized to resist militant takeovers the separatist challenges there quickly dissipated A fine grained and highly original on the ground analysis of the origins of the wider Russian Ukrainian war that broke out in 2022 this book offers broader insights into the conditions under which external intervention may trigger the rise of an armed insurgency in a society torn apart by political and ideological disagreements *Vladimir Putin and Russia? President Woodrow Wilson riding down the Champs Elysees in December 1918 to meet with the leaders of the victorious Allies at the Paris Peace Conference marked a break from a long tradition where US presidents directed foreign policy and direct engagement with foreign counterparts was not considered a central duty. Not until the arrival of Franklin D. Roosevelt's administration over a decade later would this change. In *The Diplomatic Presidency: American Foreign Policy from FDR to George H. W. Bush*, Tizoc Chavez reveals the long overlooked history of the rise of personal diplomacy as one of the core responsibilities of the modern president. The modern presidency as it took shape during the FDR era is characterized by rising expectations, sensitivity to public opinion, activism in the legislative arena, a propensity to act unilaterally, and a vast executive branch bureaucracy, all of which contributed to shaping the necessity and practice of presidential personal diplomacy. Tizoc Chavez takes a comprehensive approach and provides a thorough archival-based examination of the causes that led presidents to conduct diplomacy on a more personal level. He analyzes personal diplomacy as it was practiced across presidential administrations, which shifts the focus from the unique or contingent characteristics of individual presidents to an investigation of the larger international and domestic factors in which presidents have operated. This approach clarifies similarities and connections during the era of the modern presidency and why all modern presidents have used personal diplomacy regardless of their vastly different political ideologies, policy objectives, leadership styles, partisan affiliations, and personalities, making the practice a central aspect of the presidency and US foreign affairs. This cross-administration exploration of why the presidency as an institution resorted to diplomacy at the highest level argues that regardless of who occupied the modern White House, they turned to personal diplomacy for the same reasons: international crises, domestic politics, foreign leaders seeking them out, and a desire for control. *The Diplomatic Presidency* bridges the gap between history and political science by balancing in-depth case studies with general explanations of broader developments in the presidency and international and domestic politics for a better understanding of presidential behavior and US foreign relations today.
