Social Work Practice

- Direct professional social work practice with individuals/families, groups, and communities.

Social Work Practice With Groups

- Generic base: philosophical and knowledge foundations
Essential elements of practice: client, worker, problem, process

* Minimum size: It is commonly accepted that there should be at least three people in the group.

Common interest: this allows to move beyond individual preoccupations. Without common goals, groups cannot perform effectively. If there is no commonality, you may NOT be assessing a group but a collection of people.

Shared beliefs : it helps identify members of the group from those outside of the group.

Interdependence: Group work together to accomplish some goal or outcome. Members effort combine to achieve the outcome in a way where each person must contribute for the group to be successful.

Classification of Groups

Social Group: it is an exclusive self-organizing from of social organization

Comprised of two or more members who identify and interact with one

another on a personal basis as individuals, nature of relationship is like in a natural group

Primary group: family (relationship is based on common feeling and comprises the earliest form of human relationship)

Natural Groups: These are groups that come together spontaneously on the basis of naturally occurring events, interpersonal attraction or the

Groupwork: a working definition

Social groupwork is a method of social work that aims, in an informed way, through purposeful group experiences, to help individual's and groups to meet individual and group need, and to influence and change personal, group, organizational and community problems.

Group Definition

- Minimum size
- Common interest
- Shared beliefs
- Interdependence
- Group is defined as , "at least 2 people (usually more), gathered with common purposes or like interests in a cognitive, affective, and social interchange in single or repeated encounters". Webster, 1988
