3. Describe the colonial societies established in Latin America by the Spanish and Portuguese. (Refer to 'Society in Colonial America' on pp. 482 and 483).
4. Explain the rising demand for labor in the Spanish and Portuguese American colonies and how this demand was satisfied. (Refer to pp. 479-481. Be sure to comment on, and define, the Mita system, the *encomienda* system, and the African slave labor system).
5. The English and French didn't colonize the Americas until almost a century after the Spanish and Portuguese. Why? How were the English and French colonies both similar and different than the those of Spain and Portugal? (Refer *only* to the first two paragraphs on page 485).
