APPEALS PROCESS

2.2 Attendance and Punctuality

Regular attendance and punctuality are an essential part of the learning environment. The school expects students to attend all classes and arrive on time.

EXPECTATIONS

1. Students are expected to attend all classes and arrive on time.
2. In case of illness or emergency, a written note from the parent/guardian is required.
3. The school will require a written excuse for frequent absences.

TARDINESS

1. Students should arrive at school on time and be ready to participate in class.
2. Students who arrive late must report to the designated authority before entering the classroom.
3. Students who miss more than 10% of the school year will be subject to suspension.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

1. If a student needs to take an extended leave of absence, a written request must be submitted to the school.
2. The leave of absence request must be approved by the designated authority.
3. Approval of a leave of absence is not guaranteed.


MAKE-UP WORK

1. It is the student's responsibility to complete missed assignments and make up any missed classes or sessions.
2. For any missed assignments or sessions, the student will be given the opportunity to make up the work within a reasonable timeframe as determined by the designated authority.
