The concept of corruption has been metamorphosing as generations of human life have existed in multi diverse cultures that have encouraged borrowing of norms but one common definition remains that corruption in any culture of human life is a deviation of norms (Holmes, 2015).

The Oxford Unabridged Dictionary (2002) describes corruption as perversion or destruction of integrity in the discharge of public duties by bribery or favors while Merriam Webster's Collegiate Dictionary (2006) states that corruption is inducement to wrong by improper or unlawful means. The concise definition applied by the World Bank (1997) the abuse of public office for private gain. According to Anti-Corruption and Economic Crimes Act of Kenya 2003, corruption means an offence that involves bribery, fraud, embezzlement or misappropriation of public funds, abuse of office, breach of trust, or an offence involving dishonesty in connection with any tax, rate levied under any Act or under any written law relating to the elections of persons to public office (The Anti-Corruption and Economic Crimes Act, 2003:4).

Scholars and academicians have had encounters in vexing to delineate this phenomenon that has found comfort in all generations of human life because not all can agree that there is a standard definition that can traverse cultural miscellany, with one facet defining corruption with a legality approach while the other end defines corruption with human perspective of beauty lies in the eye of the beholder meaning that a definition of corruption in this cases can be generated on perception that the person committing the act of corruption can be freed by the law but the public perception of their act remains intact(Chayes, 2021).

In the modern world, nations, continents, states and many administrative functions that render public goods and services have grappled with the vice of corruption and Kenya is no different. Kenya as a second world country has had a rough patch of the menace of corruption that has spread through the public service. Since Kenya got independence in 1963, it has had a fair share of corruption scandals that have tainted the country's image
