Each set of religious political institutions made law, controlled land and governed people for roughly four centuries. Yet both suffered three similar upheavals and challenges: the end of empires, the rise of the modern national state and significant outward migrations from the home base of the religious tradition. Laurence suggests that the historical experience of Catholicism offers a useful model for those concerned about the contemporary Sunni Muslim leadership's attitude toward the modern state. Just as Catholicism worldwide benefited from the survival of the Vatican micro-state and its ability to exert guidance over the religious belief and practice of Catholics worldwide, so argues Laurence, Muslim majority states should continue to exert control over mosques, imam training and religious education to reconcile Islam with the rule of law and thus with the authority of the secular state. This book is based on prodigious archival research in Vatican and Ottoman Archives and on interviews conducted with senior officials responsible for Islamic affairs or public religious education in Algiers, Ankara, Casablanca, Istanbul, Oran, Rabat, Tunis and with senior interior ministry and foreign ministry officials in various European capitals responsible for relations with North African, Turkish, Qatari and Saudi ministries of Islamic and religious affairs.

Islamic Law and International Law Emilia Justyna Powell, 2019-10-18 There are twenty-nine Islamic law states (ILS) in the world today and their Muslim population is over 900 million. Breaking these restrictions might require specific software or tools, which may or may not be legal depending on the circumstances and local laws.
