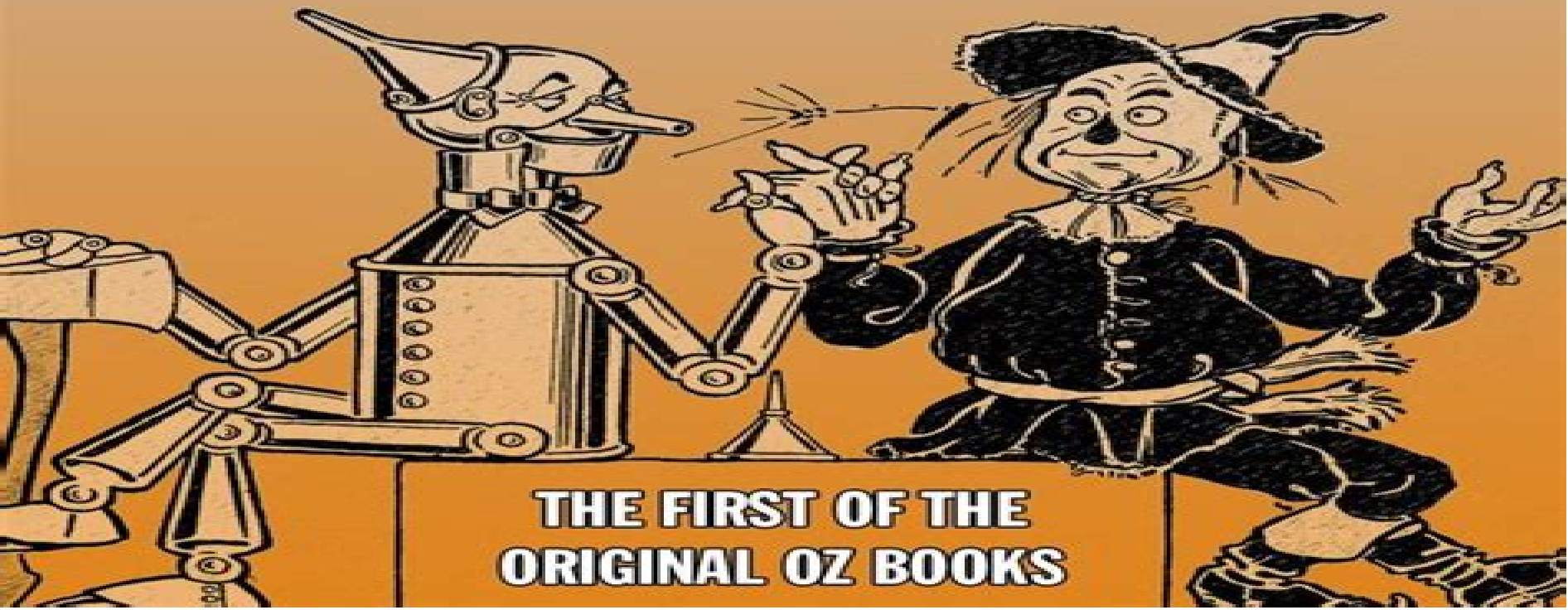

Baum dedicated the book to his good friend and comrade My Wife Maud Gage Baum. In January 1901, the George M. He made numerous attempts to bring his works to the stage and the nascent medium of film; the 1939 adaptation of the first Oz book would become a landmark of 20th century cinema.
