**Subject:** 7 grade level: Science 30

**TEKS:** 8.7A explore the processes that led to the formation of sedimentary rocks and fossil fuels

**Lesson objective(s):** The student is expected to explore the processes that led to the formation of sedimentary rocks and fossil fuels

**Differentiation strategies to meet diverse learner needs:**

**Student with visual impairment:**

1. When doing experiment, make sure it is where student can see it using CCTV Explain as you go.
2. While working on page 103 in Modification Science Workbook, either work side by side or have peer student help.
3. When working on page 103 as a class, make sure student is able to follow along using CCTV.
4. While working on pages 105-108 independently, read the questions and have student mark their answer.

### ENGAGEMENT

The teacher will review what students have already learned about Energy. See [resources below](#) [resources below](#) for help. (Slides 1-2 on PPT) While showing the remaining slides, students will take Cornell notes. (Make notes for blind student with visual impairment).

### EXPLANATION

Students will complete the Sedimentary Rock Experiment (Page 103 in Modification Science Workbook) if time does not allow, the teacher may perform the experiment and the students can watch; as long as the point gets across. This experiment will give them hands on experience on how sedimentary rock is formed. (If students complete the experiment, pair them up. If the teacher performs the experiment, have students complete page 103 while observing.) Students will need the following materials: crayon shavings, test paper or aluminum foil, and a test book. Tell the students that the crayons represent different materials, the shavings represent the breaking down of the materials (weathering, erosion, deposition), and the pressure of the test book represents the layers on top of the broken down pieces (compacting), turning it into sedimentary rock after millions of years.

### EXPLANATION

After the experiment, ask the students higher level thinking questions: "~~What is the nature that piles up over time?~~" (dead plants, animals, and trees)... "~~What happens after it gets to sedimentary rock is done?~~" (layers of pressure)... "~~Can you explain what is happening when you press the notebook on the shavings?~~" Is other words, what does the notebook represent?" (The pressure of layers building on top of one another)... "~~What is naturally found in sedimentary rock?~~" (fossil fuels)...
