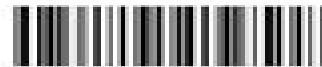

Sobolev p capacity zero are removable for the solutions and also discuss the behaviour of the solutions at In particular a certain trichotomy is proved similar to the Phragmén Lindelöf principle
