Within only two months, the United States Navy experienced two horrible accidents in 2017. What's significant about these accidents is that they occurred under oddly similar circumstances. These events thus raised a burning question about the Navy's way of functioning: What went wrong? ProPublica, a nonprofit organization that serves as a news source, wrote an article in 2019 discussing these tragic events. But who were the "Cassandras" of this situation? Why were their warnings unable to make any significant impacts? How can the US Navy learn from this?

First of all, a Cassandra must be defined. A Cassandra is someone who provides warnings or predictions of an upcoming disaster based on their personal experience, experience and expertise, but are simply ignored or disregarded. One of the Cassandra's found in the article was the dedicated safety officer from the US Navy. This officer consistently pointed out the issues about maintenance as well as training issues. He specifically pointed out the state of the USS John S. McCain, and predicted an accident in the near future. Despite his warnings, no action was taken on these matters. With the harsh authoritarian system the Navy followed, it was excruciatingly difficult for those who have different opinions to get the attention of the higher ups who had the power to make a change. The next Cassandra was the external analyst, a professional from beyond the Navy who carefully studied these incidents. They provided their research in the form of thorough reports, presenting all the likely risks and what to do about them, but since the analyst was not a part of the navy, the higher ups once again ignored all given warnings, despite the evidence and research presented. The Navy's organization is very strict, making it difficult to take in this external source's information.

The Navy has two different models that they may follow when making decisions. The first one is known as the bureaucratic model. This is a very strict structure in which people follow strict protocols, and decisions are made by those in charge. This model is excellent for guaranteeing organization and order, but prevents new ideas from being taken into consideration or for any adaptation to occur, which is very important when dealing with situations that are constantly changing, as the Navy does. According to the ProPublica article, the bureaucratic model enforced conformity and prevented anyone from pointing out areas of weakness which then resulted in people holding back on saying something when there are vulnerabilities. Next, there is the decentralized model. Essentially what this is, is that everybody has the chance to suggest their ideas no matter what status they have. Although this model does adopt a sense of openness and expand the Navy's opportunities for innovation and responding to early warnings, it
