Notes:

- First things first, sociology is the study of society. This includes the study of groups and their interactions
- A society is defined by a geographical area that share the same culture
- Sociologists study how society affects people and how people impact society
- There are all types of sociology to include sociology of religion, medicine, gerontology, sports, music, etc.
- Like most sciences, sociologists are interested in studying patterns from individuals and groups due to external factors since multiple factors impact our lives
- Sociologists analyze social factors and social institutions to determine patterns, trends, and sometimes make predictions
- Social facts are rules that govern social life. They are related to laws, morals, values, customs, rituals, etc.
- People have been thinking like sociologists long before sociology became a separate academic discipline.
 - Plato, Aristotle, Confucius, Khaldun, Voltaire
- Auguste Comte coined the view to study social patterns as positivism. He believed scientific methods to show the laws how society interacts with individuals and groups
- Harriet Martineau (First Women Sociologist) observed social issues to include economics, social class, inequalities, etc. She was known for translating Comte's work into English.
- Karl Marx was a philosopher and economist. He coined Conflict theory since he thought society was based upon the power struggles between social classes. Marx predicted capitalism would eventually collapse with communism being the successor.
- Émile Durkheim founded sociology as a discipline. Most notably for his works with the division of labor, objective 'social facts' and his work on suicide emphasizing social factors.
