

The working memory model is an active model of short term memory and explains how STM functions and is organised, proposed by Baddeley and Hitch in 19974. The WMM suggests that short term memory is made up of multiple units coordinated by the central executive, instead of one big singular unit seen in the Multi-Store Model. The central executive is the “conductor” that coordinates information and activity to and from the slave systems: the phonological loop, the visuo-spatial sketchpad and the episodic buffer. The central executive is mainly coded acoustically and visually and has a very limited capacity with no storage space. The phonological loop holds auditory information in speech based form and is split into 2 parts; the phonological store, or the ‘inner ear’, holds the words/content you hear for a short time and the articulatory control system, or the ‘inner voice’, allows you to silently repeat words and content until needed. The phonological loop is coded acoustically and has a capacity of about 2 seconds worth of what is heard. The visuo-spatial sketchpad or the ‘inner eye’ deals with 2 types of information: visual and spatial. The visual cache stores info about form and colour and the inner scribe stores the arrangement of objects in the visual field. The visuo-spatial sketchpad is mainly coded iconic and has a capacity of 3-4 objects. Finally the last slave system the episodic buffer pulls together information processed by the other slave systems, is an extra storage system and interacts with the long-term memory store. The episodic buffer is mainly coded acoustically and visually and has a capacity of 4 chunks of information, and was also recently added in 2000 by Baddeley.
