- Wells drilled into the ground tap groundwater in aquifers. This water is replenished by rain that percolates downward through soil and rock by the process of natural recharge.
- The groundwater may get used faster than it can be recharged, causing the water table to drop below the well. Water shortages would occur.
- They control the flow of water, capturing and storing a river's flow as well as rain and melting snow.
- It is released for irrigation and municipal uses, and is used to produce hydroelectric power and for recreation.
- Salt water is heated until it evaporates.
   Then it is condensed, and the resulting freshwater is collected.
- Some desalination plants use solar energy, which is slow but inexpensive and renewable. Others use fuel, which is faster but more expensive.
- They carry freshwater from where it is plentiful to where there is a great demand for it, such as to cities and agricultural areas.
