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- **Co-Teaching**
  - The process of co-teaching is interesting in that it is both a direct and indirect service that is provided under the overall process of collaboration. Teachers who are involved in co-teaching serve many functions. These teachers can at once be a consultant, a collaborator, a designer of curricula, and an instructor.
  - The definition of co-teaching is “two or more professionals jointly deliver substantive instruction to a diverse, or blended, group of students in a single physical space.”
- **Co-Teaching Approaches**
  - *One Teach, One Observe*
    - Characteristics:
      - One teacher teaches and one teacher observes
      - Gather data to identify and understand student’s academic and social functioning
      - One teacher is responsible for designing and delivering instruction to entire group
      - Other teacher observes a single student, an identified group of students, or entire group for identified behaviors
    - Advantages:
      - Requires little joint planning
      - Excellent method for teachers who are new to co-teaching
    - Disadvantages:
      - Special educator may become an “assistant” with prolonged use
