

vat Hempel's flagpole problem the black raven problem Wittgenstein's problem Why does logic work in our world etc The most fundamental theories in modern science are commonly said to be the three theory of relativity quantum mechanics and statistics However as this book will show commutative QL is more powerful and beautiful than statistics Therefore I would replace the above three by theory of relativity quantum mechanics and commutative QL
