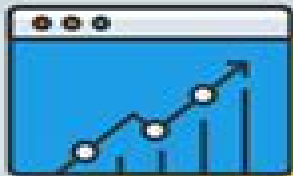
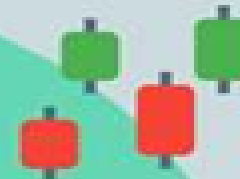

All traders use either of these methods, or a combination of them.

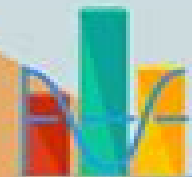
Price Action
