war existed with the United States and Noriega named himself the Maximum Leader Violence followed the next evening when a Panamanian soldier shot three American officers one First Lieutenant Robert Paz U S Marine Corps died of his wounds Witnesses to the incident a U S naval officer and his wife were assaulted by Panamanian Defense Force PDF soldiers while in police custody In the early hours of 20 December conventional task forces seized additional key points and the land approaches to Panama City The operational success of JUST CAUSE rewarded efforts by Congress and the Bush administration to avoid repeating the mistakes of Lebanon and Grenada The determination of President Bush and the enhanced authority of the Chairman and CINC combined to provide specific readily attainable objectives and responsive and effective command and control while giving the tactical commander considerable operational freedom However when shortcomings in prior planning and mistakes by local commanders embarrassed the administration General Powell acted to ensure the political success of the operation
