40% of the main points in a typical lecture First year students capture only 11% In some studies even the best note takers seem to record less than 75% of the important information People think they take good notes until they re told they don t Few of us have consciously thought about how we take notes let alone how to improve the quality of them We often reproduce the lecturer's phrases verbatim. We don't save time by systematic use of abbreviations.
