Although the index is published yearly there is no measured change as it regards political and economic policymakers Nonetheless Jamaican policymakers pay significant attention to their performance on TI's CPI Transparency International's CPI is used as the authoritative tool to assess countries corruption perceptions scores by both international governments and several international agencies The use and reference of TI s CPI does not translate as the main factor in regards to the increase and or decrease of aid flow Surprisingly there was no evidence that the CPI affected the credit rating and or investment flow into Jamaica It did indicate however that TI s CPI is reflective of the global market perceptions of Jamaica s economy Research shows that the index does change policy responses in Jamaica as government officials across varying agencies pay attention to the index and the progression and or worsening of the country's score Agroforestry P.
