

The result was spring training pay uniform contracts minimum salary levels player representation and a pension plan the very issues that would divide players and owners almost fifty years later During these years the game was led by A B Happy Chandler a hand shaking speech making singing Kentucky politician Most owners thought he would be easily manipulated unlike baseball s first commissioner the autocratic Judge Kennesaw Mountain Landis Instead Chandler's style led one owner to complain that he was the player's commissioner the fan's commissioner the press and radio commissioner everybody's commissioner but the men who pay him The Year Without a World Series Robert C.
