Oracle BPEL Process Analytics must be installed in the same Oracle home directory as the J2EE and Web Cache installation type of Oracle Application Server 10g Release 2 (10.1.2). The J2EE and Web Cache installation type provides a Web server that enables you to develop and deploy Java 2 Enterprise Edition (JEE) applications and accelerate Web site performance with Oracle Application Server Web Cache.
- Oracle Application Server Metadata Repository
Oracle Application Server Metadata Repository database schemas are stored in the Oracle Application Server Metadata Repository.
