They contend that humanistic inquiry cannot develop successfully at this time without reference to the varieties of subjective, inter-subjective, and collective experience of teachers and researchers. Such substantive accounts of the inner academic life provide appropriate and rich contexts for further study and analysis. With this volume, then, these scholars move us to explore the intersections of the social with subjectivity, with voice, ideology, and culture, and to consider the roles of these in the work of academics who study writing and literature. Taken together, the essays in this collection carry forward the idea that the personal, the candidly subjective, and inter-subjective must be part of the subject of study in humanities scholarship. They propose an understanding of the personal in scholarship that is more helpful because more clearly anchored in human experience.
