

## Year 2 Writing Checklist

These checklist lists are for the 2019-2020 National Curriculum Year writing. They are split into:

- Working Towards the Expected Standard
- Working at the Expected Standard
- Working at Greater Depth within the Expected Standard

All of the statements are progressive within and across the year so that the majority of pupils will be working on their own year goals.

### How to Use the Checklists

The year can be used to track the achievement of individual pupils to highlight the progress of groups of children who are meeting writing targets.

To judge that a pupil is working at a standard in English, look across the checklist for the school year which encompasses that child's writing that standard.

## Year 2 Writing Checklist

### Working Towards the Expected Standard

Pupils can write sentences to form a short narrative about experiences (real and fictional), after discussion with the teacher.

Identifying some common words (capital letters and full stops).

Representing spoken words like phonemes and representing spelling using carefully and making phonically plausible words.

Spelling some common exception words.

Forming lower case letters in the correct direction, some right and some left.

Forming lower case letters of the correct size relative to the writing.

Using spacing between words.

## Year 2 Writing Checklist

### Working at the Expected Standard

Pupils can write a simple, coherent sentence about their experiences (real and fictional), after discussion with the teacher.

Writing about real events, recording them simply and clearly.

Identifying most common words (capital letters and full stops) and using them.

Using phonics and phonemes correctly, not necessarily in isolation (on / and / not).

Using some punctuation (full stop / and / not).

Representing spoken words like phonemes and representing spelling using carefully.

Spelling many common exception words.

Writing capital letters and signs of the correct size, relative to the written text to cover long letters.

Using spacing between words that reflects the use of the

### Working at Greater Depth within the Expected Standard

Pupils can write effectively and coherently for different purposes, drawing on their reading to inform the vocabulary and grammar of their writing after discussion with the teacher.

Writing simple sentences, clauses and using reading experiences to their own writing.

Using the full range of punctuation taught in the year 2 writing correctly (including: apostrophe in words and contractions).

Spelling most common exception words.

Writing letters in full and words correctly in their writing (e.g. work, very, one, two, to).

Using the expected and beyond words needed to put letters in order of their writing.

\* These are stated in the year 2 writing the writing standards in the national curriculum (English Appendix 1). Teachers should refer to these to identify the words that pupils should be able to spell.

\* The words in punctuation taught in the national curriculum, which is stated within the grammar and punctuation standards in the national curriculum (English Appendix 2).
