DoDTR began during the early years of the Global War on Terror GWoT when the need to systematically improve trauma care for combat wounded resulted in the impromptu creation of a demonstration registry known then as the Combat Trauma Registry CTR The CTR was constructed by the Center for AMEDD Strategic Studies CASS trauma related information was initially abstracted into it from paper medical records received from trauma nurse coordinators TNCs at Landstuhl Regional Medical Center LRMC in Germany Shortly after the demonstration program started the Army Surgeon General approved its transition to an operational mode leading to the formation of the Joint Theater Trauma System JTTS and eventually the Joint Trauma System JTS Anesthesiologist's Manual of Surgical Procedures Richard A.
