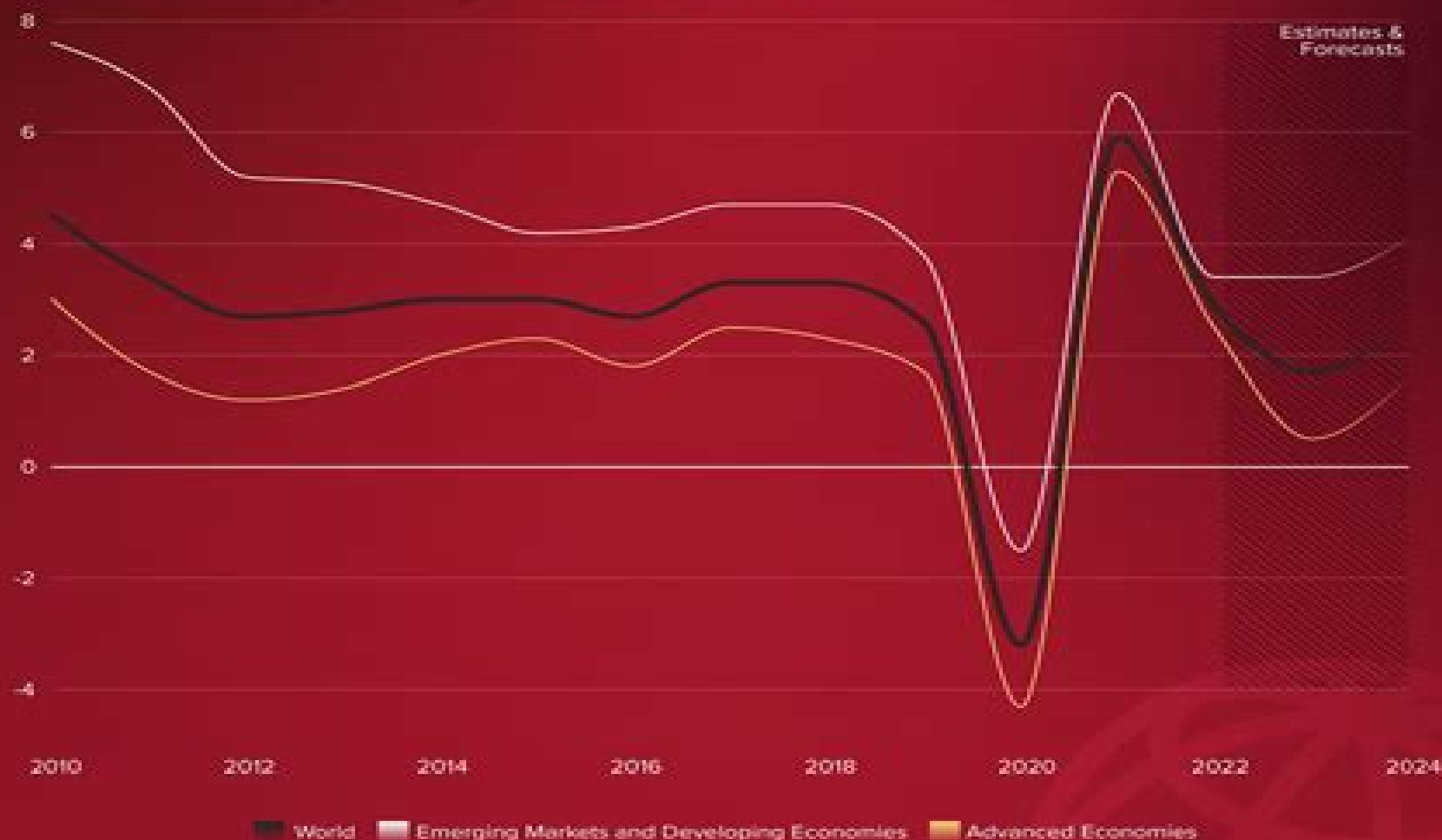


Global Economy at Risk of Recession as Growth Slows

Where the national-centric models see local government as a matter belonging to policy on decentralization, for later in the reconstruction phase the book uncovers a distinct local government dimension to peace transitions.
