How to use an interpreter - Answer-- allow enough time for session

- meet with interpreter before both of you meet the patient
- maintain appropriate seating
- speak to patient, not interpreter
- use short sentences
- allow enough silence between questions
- speak slowly and clearly
- avoid jargon
- observe nonverbal signs
- expect interpreter to give complete interpretations
- use "teach back"
- debrief with interpreter

Telephone interpreters - Answer-- use speaker phone in private room

- services charge by the amount of time used
- patient not charged
- not perfect solution (can't see body language)
