Patient stated, "I don't want my friends to see me like this". Refused treatment from PT and medications. Auscultated the lungs and found wheezing and during the assessment a cough was noticed. Patient had an open reduction fixation to open rods and screws and reported pain level scoring a 2 on a scale 0 to 10. Patient has 2 casts no sign of infection, no redness or edema, capillary refill less than 3 secs on the toes and fingers. Elevated the head of the bed for proper breathing and help with the cough. Patient was instructed to practice deep breathing exercises, take her albuterol as ordered and to get up and try to walk to prevent pneumonia from being bedbound during recovery. We suggested personal items from home and maybe some nail polish that she enjoys, and it turned out to be helpful for the patient's readiness to receive the proper treatment, she appears more interested now as we build a better rapport. Continue to monitor patient. Call light within reach.
