In order to make it permissible to break the rules in some instances, the white society created Jim Crow laws that limited the rights to be free, national citizenship and voting. In his autobiographical sketch, Richard Wright highlights several instances in which African Americans are not only excluded from the general rights of a citizen but how they are also subjected to injustice and mistreatment. Wright divides his memories into nine sections, in the first one we are introduced to his home. He lives behind the railroad tracks and has nothing in his backvard but black cinders. On one occasion Wright recalls that his group of friends engaged in a fight with white kids. Wright's friends used cinders and the white kids used broken bottles. The fight ended, soon after Wright returned home and waited for his mom in the steps nursing his wound. Wright told her what happened and is mom proceeded to ask why he was always fighting. Instead of consoling him or treating his injuries she proceeded to inflict more damage on him. The motive for this was to "impart tion
