Toby sat in the sandpit put the truck in front of him and used his hands he began to scoop up sand and fill the back of the truck. When Toby filled the back of the truck, he pushed it across the sandpit while kneeling. "Too heavy, hard to push" he commented. Toby stopped pushing and then began to empty the sand from the back of the truck. Once the sand was completely off the back of the truck, Toby pushed it across the sandpit again. "Look, I can push it fast now" he said.

Interpretation

Through this experience it is evident that Toby explores the environment and manipulates objects and experiments with cause and effect, trial and error and motion. *Toby pushes the truck across the sandpit and says "Too heavy, hard to push".
