 - Sytox Green stains green and Propidium lodide stains red
 - Fluorescent things are easier to put in a machine that can count cells for us.

- Ex. Givcogen
- Periodic Acid Schiff (PAS) shows where mucus (secretions) are prevalent
- "G" = Gobiet Cells (produce mucus)

Glycosaminoglycans/Proteoglycans

- Uses Alcian Blue Dye
- · Stains carbohydrates bound to proteins blue
- Circled in red is an Artifact (see below)
