Modernism is referred to as a period dating from approximately 1860 ~ 1970. It is used to describe the ideology of the art produced and arose as part of Western society's attempt to come to terms with the urban, industrial and secular society that degan to emerge in the mid nineteenth century. Artists challenged middle class values and embraced new technologies of the time as they were freed by realist representation due to the invention of the camera which led to the depiction of new subjects in dislocating styles that changed at an amazing pace. Their allegiance to the view was embodies in the concept of the avant-garde, a military term meaning 'advanced guard.' Modernist artists experimented abstraction and embraced the tradition of the new. The artists were regarded as being ahead of their time.

Camille Pissarro (1830 - 1903) was considered a Freech Impressionist painter born on the island of St Thomas. Impressionism(1860 - 1900n a french based movement where artists tried to capture the fleeting light effects upon objects at different times of the day. They moved from studios, to painting onsite, 'en pieth air'. Modernism was the art of the city and Paris was where all artist fled. Now, due to the invention of paint in tubes, artist are now painting on site. Cropping, and viewpoint relates to the invention of photography, but also the trade that opened up in the middle east and in particular Japan. Europe became influenced with their asymmetrical composition, urbsual viewpoints, close-ups, cropping, patterns and blackout lines. This then influenced Pissarro by asymmetrical composition, unusual viewpoint and cropping.
