Starting Programs and Opening Files

To open the Start menu

To start a program from the Start menu:

- Choose All Programs, and then select a program from the menu.

To open a file:

- Click the Start button
- 2. Click Committee
- 3. Browse to the file and double-click it.

Working with Active Programs

All open programs, folders, or documents appear on the Taskbar.

To view an active program:

- Olick the active program button on the Taskbar.
- 2. Or press ALT + TAB to cycle through all active windows.

To view notifications or monitor status:

Double-click the program or system icon.

Working with Windows Explorer

Windows Explorer is the primary tool used to browse, view, and organize files and folders in Windows 7.

To open Windows Explorer:

- 1. Click the Windows Explorer icon in the Taskbar.
- For a more detailed view of your computer's storage resources, click the Start button and choose from the merce.

To show/hide the traditional menu bar (File, Edit, etc.):

1. Fress the ALT key.

To display sub-folders in the Navigation pane:

- Click * ** or ** beside the drive or folder you want to view subfolders for.
- 2. Click 1 at or 10 to collapse sub-folders.

To port folder contents by view:

- 1. In Windows Explorer, click in the main menu bar
- 2. Choose a view from the menu.
- 3. You can also choose the size of display icons.
