motivation and retention rates at the doctoral level The goal of the study was to determine if extrinsic and intrinsic motivational factors and constraints were associated with persistence in a graduate doctoral program Data were collected from 193 doctoral and graduate students for the quantitative study while 20 doctoral and graduate students participated in a qualitative study followed by a thorough semi structured interview Inductive and deductive analyses were performed transcribed and opened while axial coding provided emergent themes and sub themes The research showed a direct relationship between financial implications attrition and retention rates and motivation in doctoral level students Many doctoral students believed the primary reason they were unable to pursue doctoral programs was based on financial hardship Doctoral students who responded to the survey added that motivation was the second significant variable that helped them continue their studies
