# Wine

## MOST POPULAR VARIETIES

### RED WINES



#### Cabernet Sauvignon

Known as the "black" of wine, Cabernet Sauvignon is a deep, dark red wine. Best from Napa, CA, Chile and Australia. Pairs well with: beef, lamb.



#### Shiraz

Bold and spicy with a hint of black pepper. Best from Napa, CA, Chile and Australia. Pairs well with: meat, lamb, with a variety of foods.



#### Merlot

Known as the "black" of wine, Merlot is a deep, dark red wine. Best from the U.S. west coast & Australia. Pairs well with: any red meat.



#### Pinot Noir

Known as the "black" of wine, Pinot Noir is a deep, dark red wine. Best from France, Austria and Oregon. Pairs well with: salmon, chicken and Japanese.

#### Wine body and Tannin Level

For red wines, these terms are often thrown around, but are seldom explained. **Wine body** defines how the wine feels in your mouth. It's similar to the thickness of milk. Lighter is very watery, medium bodied is comparable to regular milk, and full bodied is more like cream. **Tannins** are naturally occurring polyphenols found in plants, seeds, fruit skins and other organic matter. Tannins add dryness, bitterness and astringency in the middle of your tongue and the front part of your mouth.

### WHITE WINES



#### Chardonnay

Known as the "white" of wine, Chardonnay is a light, pale yellow wine. Best from Burgundy, France and California. Pairs well with: seafood, chicken.



#### Sauvignon Blanc

Known as the "white" of wine, Sauvignon Blanc is a light, pale yellow wine. Best from Loire region of France and New Zealand. Pairs well with: seafood, poultry.



#### Riesling

Known as the "white" of wine, Riesling is a light, pale yellow wine. Best from Germany and the Eastern U.S. Pairs well with: spicy food, poultry.



#### Pinot Grigio

Known as the "white" of wine, Pinot Grigio is a light, pale yellow wine. Best from Italy, Oregon and California. Pairs well with: seafood, pasta.

#### Dry vs. Sweet

Another way wine is described is with dryness or sweetness, depending on the amount of residual sugar left in the wine. Residual sugar is any natural grape sugars that are left after fermentation. The juice of wine grapes starts out with a sugar, which yeast eats and ferments to create alcohol. If the fermentation process uses up all the sugar, it is a **dry wine**. If the fermentation process stops before it uses up all the sugar, due to the alcohol content killing the yeast, or temperature, there will be more residual sugar, producing a **sweet wine**.

### DESSERT WINES



#### Champagne

Known as the "white" of wine, Champagne is a light, pale yellow wine. Best from the Champagne region of France. Pairs well with: fruits, nuts or crumbles.



#### Moscato

Known as the "white" of wine, Moscato is a light, pale yellow wine. Best from pretty much everywhere. Pairs well with: pretty much anything.



#### Sherry

Known as the "white" of wine, Sherry is a light, pale yellow wine. Best from the Cádiz region of Spain. Pairs well with: omelets, cheese.



#### Port

Known as the "white" of wine, Port is a light, pale yellow wine. Best from Douro Valley region of Portugal. Pairs well with: Game, fruits.

#### Why is dessert wine different?

Dessert is different from regular wine because of the sugar level and the alcohol level. These levels can be increased in a few different ways. Sometimes grapes rot on the vine, which increases the sugar. Other times, winemakers can add sugar either before or after fermentation. They can also use a process called fortification, where they add a high alcohol spirit like brandy. Finally, winemakers can remove water to concentrate the sugar, usually by air drying or freezing the grapes.

## GLASS GUIDE



#### Large Red

Bottle shape lets the wine to breathe. Best for: Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot Noir, Merlot.



#### Small Red

Narrower, directs wine to the nose. Best for: Shiraz, Zinfandel.



#### Large White

Snaller than red with a wide bowl. Best for: Chardonnay, Chablis.



#### Small White

Narrower still, shape directs the aroma. Best for: Riesling, Pinot Gris, Chardonnay.



#### Flute

Enhances longevity of bubbles. Best for: Champagne, Sparkling wines.



#### Dessert

Small, directs wine to back of the mouth. Best for: Sherry, Port.

## LABEL GUIDE

**PRODUCER** - Name of the producer that produced this wine.

**VINTAGE** - Year the grapes were harvested. A slight difference in taste.

**VARIETY** - Name of the grape variety. At least 75% of that type of grape.

**REGION** - Name of the region. For example, Napa Valley.

**ALCOHOL CONTENT** - Percentage of alcohol. How bold the wine tastes.
