By 1938, Joseph Stalin, to a great extent, converted Russia from a backwards agricultural state to one of the most advanced industrial states in the world. As opposed to Lenin, who adapted Marxist ideas in order to recover the economy after the conflicts of the revolution, Stalin was more rigid and was able to transform Russia from an agrarian society to an industrial (and military) superpower. Stalin abandoned the New Economic Policy (NEP) and made use of a series of Five Year Plans which placed emphasis on the ideas of collectivisation and industrialisation. Stalin had a highly centralised system of government and economic control. (His "cult personality"). His use of terror and propaganda to control the nation which further contributed towards Russia's radical transformation. This essay aims to explore how the points mentioned above changed Russia from a backwards agricultural state to an industrial superpower.
