But the worst was not come yet the storm continued with such fury that the seamen themselves acknowledged they had never seen a worse

We had a good ship but she was deep laden and wallowed in the sea so that the seamen every now and then cried out she would founder

It was my advantage in

one respect that I did not know what they meant by FOUNDER till I inquired However the storm was so violent that I saw what is not often seen the master the boatswain and some others more sensible than the rest at their prayers and expecting every moment when the ship would go to the bottom In the middle of the night and under all the rest of our distresses one of the men that had been down to see cried out we had sprung a leak another said there was four feet water in the hold
