

SOAP Note for Counseling

Subjective: Information relevant to what the client reveals in the session.



Example: The client reported changes in mood and low energy level.



Objective: Factual information, e.g. symptoms, the client's appearance, orientation, behaviors, mood or affect.



Example: The client was oriented x 3.

Assessment: Your clinical impressions and interpretation of the objective and subjective information.



Example: Depressed mood and depression

Plan: What do you, as the clinician, plan to do with the client at the next session?



Example: Give psychiatric referral
