La première partie étudie les variants du contrat de travail, précise les pouvoirs de l'employeur avant de décrypter la protection dont jouit le salarié avant de passer en revue les différentes formes de rupture du contrat. Si le droit du travail est réputé protecteur des salariés, l'auteur s'efforce cependant de montrer que les évolutions législatives récentes tendent à favoriser des procédures de conciliation parfois moins favorables. La seconde partie présente l'action et le rôle des syndicats ainsi que les dispositions législatives qui encadrent les conflits qui peuvent survenir dans la vie d'une société.
