



Today it is almost axiomatic that invention be the primary concern of an architect and the only means of expressing creativity. But this is not always the case. There are projects in which the architect yields to the lure of invention, but there are others where it is the pleasure of using the tools of the architectural trade that inspires work. The architect, armed with the knowledge of the discipline, pursues a design based on a careful application of established architectural principles.

The approach to the problems posed by the Villahermosa Palace set aside any personal expression, and instead employed the knowledge of the building—both historical and technical—to find their solution. In other words, in this project I was able to revisit the building's history and to reconfigure earlier architects' interventions, tearing down the recent structure, and reversing what could be considered the latest version of the old palace, will build up the system of walls parallel to the Pinar del Prado, such a reversal established another structure, which starts from the new entry defined by the garden facade built as a consequence of the last acquisition of land.

When we trace the origins of what was to become the Villahermosa Palace, we find a small building initially erected in the mid-seventeenth century by the Italian nobleman Alessandro Pini della Mirandola as a residence in Madrid appropriate to his rank. An anonymous painting currently housed in the Thyssen-Bornemisza collection shows the palace as it once was: a two-story building clad in stucco scored to imitate masonry with imposing grills to protect the windows.¹ Records show that Francesco Santero was the architect. In 1771 the palace was handed over to the duke of Villahermosa, who commissioned Manuel Martín Rodríguez and Silvestre Pérez to draw up renovation plans. Although drawings of these projects have survived, they do not clarify what the architects' contribution was to the definitive construction of the palace.

Having said that, the Villahermosa Palace as we know it today is attributed to the architect Antonio López Aguado, whose work reveals the influence of Juan de Villanueva, both in the careful attention to proportion and in the precise choice of materials. It seems reasonable to assume that in a first stage, the
