Un autre Israël est possible Dominique Vidal, Michel Warschawski, 2012-11-09 Durant l'année 2011 en Israël jusqu'à 500 000 hommes et femmes l'équivalent de près de 4 millions en France ont manifesté contre le saccage colonial de l'éducation du logement de la santé et de l'État social. Although the violence with which the word Palestine is often associated remains a mystery for many people, it can be rationally explained. The book's introduction reserves a few surprises and its conclusion offers readers contemporary perspectives in light of historical experience. This study starts out with a historical chronology of the Jewish-Arab conflict in Palestine before examining political and ethical debates which accompanied the development of Palestinian nationalism and of Jewish nationalism.
