 - categorical: a person either has a psychological disorder or does not
 - dimensional: considers psychological disorders along a continuum in which people vary in degree rather than in kind; different than diagnostic criteria

 - disorders are described in terms of observable symptoms
 - client must meet specific criteria to receive a particular diagnosis
